JUNIOR SHOW RESULTS

Clover Classic. The Clover Classic Show was held on the weekend of March 18 & 19 with the heifer show being held on March 18. The judge was Jason Duggin from Athens, Georgia. There were 25 Simmental and Percentage Simmental, so the Simmental exhibitors were very strong and also from at least three different states.

The Grand Champion Simmental Heifer was AK/NDS Twizler sired by W/C Wide Track 694Y and shown by Allie Anderson of Westminster, SC. The Reserve Grand Champion Simmental Heifer was KWIN Uno Harriet 612D shown by Thomas Smith of Pleasant Garden, NC. Harriet is a daughter of WLE Uno Mas X549.

In the first Simmental Percentage Show of the Clover Classic, Grand Champion Percentage Simmental was Georgina's Dream D1 shown by Bailey Durham of Danbury, NC. Georgina's Dream is sired by JL Dream Grade 492. The Reserve Grand Champion Percentage Simmental was TX Homewrecker, exhibited by Haylee Creamer of Amherst, Virginia. Homewrecker is a daughter of TX Apollo. Congratulations to all these exhibitors and a huge thanks to April Bowman of the Forsyth Extension Service and all the volunteers that made this show a big success.

WNC Spring Fling.

The NC Junior Beef Spring Fling was held in Fletcher on April 15. In the purebred Simmental Show, the judge selected

B&K Cream Soda as his Grand Champion Heifer. This heifer is sired by HPF Quantum Leap Z952 and was shown by Walker Housley of Dayton, Tennessee. The Reserve Grand Champion Simmental Heifer was 3 Aces Mignonne D406 and shown by Anne Meier of Clinton, Tennessee. This heifer is sired by W/C SCH Mohican 214Y. In the very competitive Percentage Simmental Show, the judge selected TL Miss Sioux 59 shown by Andrew Meier as his Grand Champion Percentage Simmental. Andrew is also from Clinton, Tennessee and his heifer is a daughter of Mr Hoc Broker. The Reserve Grand Champion was 3 Aces Lady shown by Mary Margaret Smith of Westminster, SC. Tyler Stutsman of Hills, Iowa was the judge.

- ◆ Open to all states. Cattle are not required to be halter broken.
- ◆ All bulls must be under 36 months of age and must be semen tested at 12 months or older. Consign bulls that are ready to work. Bulls over 18 months old should also be trich tested.
- ◆ Photographs must be high quality. Please feel free to contact a professional. Call NCSA or DP Sales for recommendations.
- ◆ Deadline for nomination forms is July 7, 2017. There will be a \$25 fee if DP Sales has to write your footnote.
- ◆ Deadline for photographs to be in the July/August *Register* ad is July 1, 2017. Please have Tattoo or ID numbers with the photograph. Deadline for any photo to be in the sale catalog is July 23, 2017.
- ◆ Sale cattle need to be genetically clean and free of defects. You are encouraged to check the homozygous black status of your consignment.

Guidelines for Applying for the Outstanding NC Junior Simmental Member

Top Junior will receive either cash or prize worth \$150.

Qualification:

- Must have attended the NCSA annual meeting within the last 2 years or helped with lunch for the Fall Harvest Sale within the last 2 years (This requirement will be lax the first year)
- Junior is not eligible if won Top Junior the previous year.

Point System to compete for Top Junior of the Year

- 6 points - Attending County Cattlemen's Meeting (maximum 12 points)
- 20 points - Attending NC Cattlemen's Convention
- 20 points - Manned Simmental Booth at one function in the state (Annual meeting and Fall Harvest Sale don't count here)
- 10 point - First in Showmanship @ state level
- 8 points - First in Showmanship @ county or circuit show
- 8 points - Second in showmanship @ state level
- 5 points - Second in showmanship @ county or circuit show
- 5 points - Third in showmanship @ state level
- 3 points - third in showmanship @ county or circuit show
- 10 points - Participate in Livestock Judging
- 10 points - Participate in Skillathon
- 10 points - Lead a group or man a station at Farm Animal Days
- BONUS - 5 extra points may be earned by participating in a community service (must be documented and signed by service leader)

Additional Rules:

- Only one state level show is eligible for points. Therefore pick the highest placing. (example...If you placed 3rd at NCJBRU and 2nd at NC State Fair in showmanship you would only be eligible for 8 points).
- Only one county or circuit show is eligible for points. Therefore pick the highest placing.
- Counting only one Livestock Judging competition is allowed.
- Counting only one Skillathon contest is allowed
- Counting only one Farm Animal Days allowed
- Documentation of participation is required. A note or a signed program by the judge or person in charge is sufficient.
- All events eligible for points must occur within the same year (example...If applying for Top Junior in 2017 all events must have occurred within 2017)
- All documentation must be to the NC Junior Leader by July 1
- Announcement of winner will be announced at the NCSA annual meeting and NC Fall Harvest Sale
